



**Bean Tavern, Raymond (L):** This 1750s structure, home to town meeting during the colonial era, was recently purchased by the town. It now needs restoration and a new purpose.



**Flying Yankee, Lincoln (R):** The 1935 stainless steel train has undergone decades of restoration. The re-organized friends' group hopes to acquire it from DOT, finish it, and get it operational again.

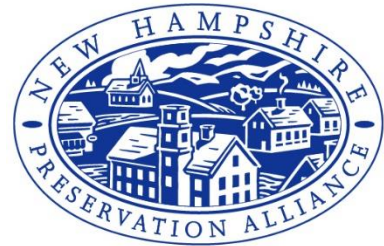
**St. John's Methodist Church, Jefferson (L):** Recently vacated by the local historical society, this 1868 church will soon need a new owner and creative new use.



**Hill Center Church (R):** An 1800 meetinghouse with 1847 renovations, the rural landmark needs some restoration and new programmatic use to remain used and relevant.
